Michael Jackson

- August 29, 1958, Indiana, US
- nickname: King of Pop
- singer, songwriter, dancer, composer
- start singing at 5 with his brothers
- lots of hit albums: Thriller, Bad ...
- very successful / famous / rich
- June 25, 2009, Los Angeles (50)



Queen Victoria

- 1819
- Queen of the United Kingdom (Great Britain and Ireland) and Empress of India
- reign / 1837-1901
- royal residence: Buckingham Palace, London
- 9 children
- 1901



Shakespeare

- 1564, Stratford-upon-Avon
- nickname: The Bard of Avon
- poet, playwright, actor
- very famous plays: Romeo and Juliet, MacBeth, Hamlet
- create the Globe Theatre / London / 1599
- 1616, Stratford-upon-Avon



Agatha Christie

- September 15, 1890, Devon, England
- crime writer of novels, short stories and plays
- create two very famous detectives: Hercule Poirot and Miss Marple
- Second World War / work in a pharmacy / study poisons
- famous novels: Murder on the Orient Express, Death on the Nile
- January 12, 1976 (85)



Charlie Chaplin

- April 16, 1889, London
- very poor parents
- actor, filmmaker, composer
- move to America / 1910
- 1914: create The Tramp: poor man, small moustache, big shoes, walking stick
- famous films: The Kid (1921), The Gold Rush (1925), Modern Times (1936).
- December 25, 1977, Vevey, Switzerland



Charles Dickens

- 7 February 1812, Portsmouth, England
- writer (15 novels and hundreds of short stories)
- popular / famous
- 1843: A Christmas Carol
- 1850: David Copperfield
- 10 children
- 1870 (58)



Thomas Edison

- February 11, 1847, Ohio, U.S.
- inventor, scientist, businessman
- live / work in New Jersey
- invent: phonograph 1877 /
- electric light bulb 1879
- October 18, 1931, New Jersey



Henry VIII

- 1491
- King of England and Ireland
- reign / 1509-1547
- royal residence: Hampton Court, London
- marry / 6 times
- 1547



Charles Lindbergh

- February 4, 1902 Detroit, Michigan
- nickname: Lucky Lindy
- US airmail pilot
- May 20-21, 1927 / cross / Atlantic Ocean / solo / on board The Spirit of St. Louis / age: 25

- 1974, Hawaï



Louis Armstrong

- 1901, New Orleans, Louisiana
- great jazz musician, singer, trumpet player
- nickname "satchmo" / big mouth
- live / New York City
- lots of hit records: What A Wonderful World, Oh When The Saints.
- play with: Ella Fitzgerald / Duke Ellington
- July 6, 1971 in Queens, NYC



Beatrix Potter

- 1866. London
- live in the Lake District
- writer
- publish books for children
- 1902: create her hero Peter Rabbit
- illustrate her books
- 1943
